About CISS

The Society operates Aspengrove School (the School) and the Aspengrove School Early Learning (the ELC). The School is an independent school delivering the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum and offering programs from Kindergarten to Grade 12. The ELC offers a Junior Kindergarten program for ages 3 and 4, and an Out of School Care and Summer programs for ages 3-12. Collectively, these programs are referred to as Aspengrove School. Aspengrove School's mission is to challenge and inspire all members of its community to act with purpose as compassionate, knowledgeable and principled global citizens. Our educational framework is based on curiosity and reflection, whether in the classroom, on the athletic field, or in the community. We encourage students at all ages to ask 'how?' and 'why?' so that they might construct their own knowledge through inquiry. The result: students become conscientious critical thinkers who understand their world.

Proposal Guidelines

Proposals will be accepted until 4:00pm PST, March 6, 2020. All proposals must be signed by an official agent or representative of the company submitting the proposal.

If the organization submitting a proposal must outsource or contract any work to meet the requirements contained herein, this fact and the name and description of the contracted parties must be clearly stated in the proposal. Additionally, all costs outlined in the proposal must include any outsourced or contracted work.

All costs must be itemized with an explanation of each associated fee and allocated to the Society's two operating units: the Early Learning Centre and Aspengrove School.

Contract terms and conditions will be negotiated upon selection of the winning bidder for the RFP. All contractual terms and conditions will be subject to review by the Society's legal representative.

Shortlisted interviews shall occur March 10th and 11th and decisions shall be communicated by 5:00pm April 17, 2020.
